G. DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

1. General Observations/Remarks of the Project on:

1.1 Background

The project has two major components. One is Protection of Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madarganj Road from the Erosion of Dudhkumar River, which is situated at Bhurungamari Upazilla under Kurigram District. Other is Bank Revetment work at left bank of Teesta River from Gunaigach to Bazra Senior Madrasha at Ulipur Upazilla in Kurigram District.

The backgrounds of the two components are as follows.

Protection of Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari- Madarganj Road:

The Dudhkumar River is flowing along the right bank at Bongasonahat, Bamondanga, Barobari Kaligonj and Tangonmari. The aforesaid area is badly affected by erosion during the rainy season. Moreover, the embankments of "Kurigram Irrigation & flood control Project (North Unit)" are 800.00m and 20.00m away from the Bongasonahat & Tangonmari area respectively. At Bomondanga & Barobari-Kaligonj the flood embankment has been engulfed by the river during flood 2006, 2008 & 2009. During the flood 2008 & 2009 almost 250/290 nos. houses were totally damaged.

The Government of Bangladesh was seriously concerned with damaging impact of the right bank erosion of the right bank of Dudhkumar River under Kurigram District.

A Technical Study was conducted by the Technical committee constituted by the BWDB. The report of the Technical Study was published on September, 2009. The Technical committee recommended constructing 2100m bank protective work along the right bank of Dudhkumar river at Bongasonahat, Bamandanga, Barobari-Kaligonj and Tangonmari.

As Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madarganj Road at Bongosonahat area were in a great threat from the river erosion, Honorable Advisor to the Prime Minister, Establishment and Administration Affairs requested the Minister of Water Resources to take immediate necessary action for the Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madarganj Road at Bongosonahat area from the severe erosion of Dudhkumar river. Accordingly, to protect Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari- Madarganj Road, protective work 1.10 km (from km. 0.000 to km.1.100) instead of 1.30km due to incorporate 1150.00m



dredging work at Bongasonahat area was proposed in the DPP as per recommendation of the Technical Committee as a part of the Technical Committee report.

In view of the above reality and on the basis of publice demands, this DPP has been prepared for the protection of the sensitive eroding area.

Bank Revetment work at Gunaigach to Bozra Senior Madrasha:

The left bank erosion of the Teesta River had been taking place since long. During the Financial year 2008-09 & 2009-10, 400 meter bank revetment work was implemented along the left bank of Teesta River under "River bank protection & Development and Town protection Project (Phase-4)"

Both the completed Sub-projects have been proved effective to reduce extent of bank erosion. At present 150 ha agricultural land, 50nos. Pacca house, 150nos. Semi-pacca house, 5 nos. Bridge & culvert, 3nos. Regulator including many other valuable public and private properties became most vulnerable due to river erosion. To conduct the study for protection of Teesta left bank at this vulnerable area a Technical Committee was formed by the BWDB. The report of the Technical Committee was published on April , 2012, The Technical Committee recommended for constructing 1800m bank protective work along the left bank of Teesta river from Gunaigach to Bazra Senior Madrasha and 4.200 km Embankment re-sectioning as well. Accordingly, to protect BWDB embankment and adjacent area along with huge number of Govt. & Semi-govt. Infrastructures from Gunaigach to Bazra Senior Madrasha area 1800m protective work (Chainage from km 86.000 to km 87.200 = 1200 meter in Gunaigach Union and km 80.600 to km 80.900, km. 81.300 ti km. 81.600 = 600.00 meter in Bazra Union and 3.00 km instead of 4.200 km embankment re-sectioning (from km 78.800 to km 81.800) due to incorporate 1000.00 m dredging work was proposed in this DPP as per recommendation of the Technical Committee as a part of the Technical Committee report.

But Variation between DPP cost and contract price occurred due to increase in market price of the construction materials, labour cost etc. Based on this situation, a detailed discussion was made in the 1st meeting of the Steering committee of this project held on 21-07-2013 chaired by the Senior Secreatary in the Ministry of Water Resources. In the meeting it was decided to review the design of dredging work at Teesta and Dudhkumar River by design expert

After field visit, Design expert opined vide memo no 01/se/Design circle-6/827 date: 13-02-2014 that dredging work in the Dudhkumar river are no longer necessary and execution of bank revetment work will earth adjacent to revetment work.

As per recommendation of Technical Committee and as per approved Design, additional 200m bank protectiver work needed to be incorporated in the RDPP than the approved DPP. It could be mentioned here that the additional 200m bank revetment work was included in the original DPP.

After approval of this project execution of 434 m bank revetment work at Sonahat Bridge were started at the end of 2012-13 Bhurungamari-Madarganj Road near Sonahat Bridge became at risk as the first flood 2013 of Dudhkumar river hit the area local district adminstration along with MoWR opined for immediate action to protect the road as because the road connects Bangasonaht land Port. As a force measure 75 kg new synthetic bags were dumped to protect the road the payment was not made which needs to be incorporated in the concern packages work as well as in the RDPP.

Besides this, in Gunaigach area including the concerned work active morphological changes took place in last 2/3 floods after the approval of the DPP. So, for the sustainability of the work it was essential to have some technical guideline from the design office to review the design. In reviewed



design a dyke with compacted earth was provided along with the revetment work which was not incorporated in original contract and the original contracts need to be revised. It could also be mentioned that during the field visit the design expert observed the reach location at Gunaigach & Bazra location. Construction of retired embankment in that point was costly as well as required land aquisition for which they recommended resectioning of embankment from km 84.700 to km 88.700 (length 4.10km) to provide flood protection in Gunaigach & Bazra area which needed to be incorporated in the RDPP. The location of Shoal removal/dredging work in the Teesta river has been shifted (from km 85.00 to km 86.00 instead of km 86.00 to km 87.00) with design without changing the length & cross-section in the reviewed design. As such in the Gunaigach & Bazra portion of the project, the length of the re-sectioning of the embankment (village road) had to be incorporated in this RDPP.

So the reasons for DPP revision could be summarised as follows.

- * Increase in contract price due to increase in market price of all construction materials and labour cost in the year 2012-13. As because the DPP was prepared by the rate FY2010-11.
- * Due to morphological change in the project area according to the approved/reviewed design revetment and re-sectioning work length increased.
- * According to the Design expert's recommendation, the dredging work in the Dudhkumar River was dropped.

Reasons for 2nd Revision:

In the monthly ADP Review Meeting held on September, 2015 at MoWR, a discussion was held on the morphological change of Teesta River at Gunaigach and Bazra area of Kurigram district due to flood/2015 which caused severe damages of ongoing works under this project and it's up & down streams. According to the decisions of ADP Review Meeting the honourable Minister for Ministry of Water Resources instructed to construct a team to visit the project area and to submit a report . Accordingly a three member's team comprising the Joint Chief, MoWR, the Chief Planning, BWDB, Dhaka & Superintending Engineer, Design Circle-VI, Dhaka visited the project area during 07.10.2015 to 09.10.2015 and submitted a report on 25.10.2015. As per approved 1st revised DPP the bank revetment work at left bank of Teesta River from km 86.000 to km 86.800 = 800 meter was more or less completed (80%) Duing flood of 2015 out of 800m, 115 meter at the U/S portion was washed out Another 2(two) packages of river bank protective work (km. 80.600 to km. 80.900= 300 meter & km 86.800 to km 87.200 = 400meter), Some quantity of CC blocks have already been manufactured. According to the recommendation of the Team the ongoing bank revetment work has been stopped. Instead of bank revtment work a T-head Groyne at Gunaigach at a length of 300 meter & a Spur at Bazra at a length of 200 meter to be constructed using the CC blocks manufactured under package no Kuri-01/2013-14 & Kuri-02/2013-14. Rehabilitation of 285 meter (rest of 80% completed protective work of 800 meters) bank revetment work with U/S end termination along with a Tie Bundh behind its. Also a armouring/permanent protective work at the end of eroded embankment at km 84.700 to resist further expansion of breach of embankment. Estimated cost of T-head Groyne, Spur, Rehabilitation of protective work, Semi permanet protective work & a Tie Bundh has been enclosed in 5th meeting of steering committee of this project held on 25-10-2015 chaired by the additional secretary, Ministry of Water Resources. As per decisions of the said meeting present 2nd Revised DPP has been recast with total estimated cost of Tk. 5480.27 lakh which is 0.07% less than the approved 1st revised DPP.



A DPEC meeting was held on 10-12-2015 on the 2nd revised DPP chaired by the secretary, Ministry of Water Resources. As per decisions of the said meeting present 2nd Revised DPP was recast with total estimated cost of Tk. 5480.27 lakh which is 0.07% less than the approved 1st revised DPP.

1.2 Justification/Adequacy

Safety of huge immovale properties, valued taka 10074.00 lakh (at current market prise) located in the vicinity of affected area at Kurigram district was ensured against proposed investment cost of Tk.5480.27 lakh. To protect Sonahat bridge and Bhurungamari-Madargonj road which is the main road of Sonahat land port and Gunaigach and Bazra areas from the erosion of Dudhkumar and Dharla river respectively. The project was very much justified.

There was a direct relevance of the project to the objective stated above. Immediate objective of Bank protection form River bank erosion and the Altimate objective was the safety of lives & properties and its econimic impacts was fulfilled for improved environmental impacts.

As for its relevance with the water sector objectives, the project was in line with the policy and macro level plan objective of GOB for poverty reduction as laid down in PRSP.

1.3 Objectives

*To protect Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madarganj road in Bongasonahat area of Bhurungamari Upazilla and all immovable public and private properties situated in the project area, approximate value of which Tk. 10074 lakh, by implementation of river bank protection work for a length of 1.30 km.

- * To reduce vulnerability of river erosion by implementation of 0.685 km. Bank revetment work, 1 no. Spur, 1 no Groyne along the left Bank of the Teesta River & 3000 meter embankment resectioning work along the left Bank of Teesta River at Bazra Upazilla Ulipur in Kurigram District. Huge immovable public & private properties with estimated total worth of Tk. 8542.00 lakh dispersed in the vicinity of affected area will be saved from river erosion.
- * To solve the problems of flooding, river- bank erosion, sedimentation, flow pattern in different seasons and environmental degradation (water pollution, salinity intrusion, ecological problems, fisheries, agriculture, foresty etc.) in the project area by dredging.
- * To reduce the extreme seismic events, human intervention and climate change on the morphological development of the river in the project area by dredging.
- * The overall objective of the project is to provide safety of human lives, properties and infrasturctures and to maintain & improve economic activities, trade and commerce.

Bangladesh is a riverine country and bank line erosion of different rivers has been a recurrent effect. River bank erosion in alluvial lands of Bangladesh is a complex and dynamic thrust of nature due of strong onrush of water and major variation in between normal water flow and surges of inflow during monsoon & post monsoon period in each year. The monsoon discharge of the major rivers is so large that there is recurrence of floods every year. Sometimes it becomes very severe and causes immense damages impacted by occurrence of devastating river erosion. This has significant social and economic impacts. The loss of land crop and property has led to landlessness and impoverishment of thousands of dwellers living within bank lines.

In this context, there have been a growing concern and reassessment of the economic and socio-political benefits of protecting important towns, infrastructure, hats and bazars as well as agricultural land. The issue has been given due importance in the national planned documents for water sector and prioritized strategic locations of river banks have been stressed for phased implementation of river bank protection programme at the apex level.

In this context, present project that have been implemented last June/2017 is very much rationale. The overall objective of the project is to reduce environmental degradation and human hazards due to river erosion with ensuring safety of lives and properties around the area. Throughout the creation of bank revetment works, safety of establishment worth value of Tk 18616.00 Lakh was ensured against river erosion.

3. Brief description on planning and financing of the project and its applicability.

Project Identification: Since Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madargonj Road at Bongosonahat area at the right bank of Dudhkumar River and Gunaigach to Bazra senior Madrasa area at the left Bank of Teesta River were in a great threat from the river erosion, Honourable Adviser to the Prime Minister, Establishment and Administration Affairs requested to the Minister for Water Resources to take immediate necessary actions for the protection of Sonahat Bridge and Bhurungamari-Madargonj Road at Bongosonahat area and Gunaigach to Bazra senior Madrasa area from the severe erosion of Dudhkumar and Teesta river.

• Project Preparation:

A technical committee was formed by BWDB to examine the feasibility of the project. Accorngly the technical committee visited the project area. After verification & study the technical committee recommended to implement the project. As per recommendation of the technical committee the field office prepared a DPP and submitted to concerned authority.

6. Remarks & Recommendations of the Project Director:

In this project, 1.93 km Bank protection work (1.3 km along the right bank of Dudhkumar river near Sonahat Bridge, 0.632 km along the left bank of Teesta river at Gunaigach and Bazra), a T-head Groyne at Gunaigach and a Spur at Bazra was constructed. All the items, Revetment works, T-head Groyne and Spur are functioning well as planned to protect the Sonahat bridge and Bhurungamari-Madargonj road from the erosion of Dudhkumar river and Gunaigach to Bazra senior Madrasha from the erosion of Teesta river. It is protecting the immovable properties of the project area (As estimated in the RDPP). Moreover, the river flow has been diverted from the bank and reclaimed huge land after construction of T-head Groyne and Spur. As such the safety of flood control embankment, human livelihood and properties have been increased. Proper monitoring and regular maintenance of the bank revetment works will be continued to ensure the sustainability of the project. Otherwise, the benefits of the project might be hampered.
