#### G. DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

### 1. General Observations/Remarks of the Project on :-

#### 1.1 Background: -

The river Bhairab and Rupsha in the Khulna district is a tidal river. The river traffic in this portion of the rivers is always busy and big Ships, Launches, Cargoes, Steamers, Burges etc are always moving in the river. Due to heavy traffic in the river and tidal fluctuation created by the high and low tides, the Bhairab and Rupsha river banks are always eroding. To save the Khulna city and adjacent areas such as Hospital Ghat, Answar flour mills, Roosevelt Jetty, Daulotpur College areas from the river erosion, Khulna Town Protection Project has been implemented by the Water Development Board previously. Adjacent to the upstream of Khulna town protection project, Roosevelt Jetty, Mongla Port Authority offices and residential areas are situated. This area is being danger due to continuous river bank erosion of Bhairab River. If the erosion continues further, a huge damage of Mongla Port Authorities areas will be occurred. To save the area from the river bank erosion, at least 1078.00m river bank protection work is urgently required. In addition to, previously constructed protective works are also damaged and about 212.00 m works need to be repaired.

Chairman, Mongla Port Authority wrote a letter to the Director General BWDB vide his Memo No. 18.14.0158.422.24.10.2015-62, dated: 05.08.2015 (Appendix-A). In the letter Mongla Port Authority requested to BWDB for taking immediate appropriate measures for protection of the Mongla Port Authority offices and residential areas from the erosion of the Bhairab River. After that, The Director General, BWDB ordered to prepare a DPP for the protection of that area from the river bank erosion (copy enclosed). It may be mentioned here that Mongla Port Authority and Roosevelt Jetty are very important in the South-Western region of Bangladesh.

On the other hand, residences of Khulna Divisional Commissioner, District Judge, Deputy Commissioner, Superintendent of Police are situated on the right bank of Rupsha river in Khulna city area. Government high official's residential areas are destroying day by day due to river bank erosion and wave action. Several times this issue is raised in District Co-ordination Meeting and request to save the government properties from river erosion (Appendix-A). Commissioner, Khulna Division also requested to save the residential areas of government high officials. On 14.09.2015, Honorable Minister, Ministry of Water Resources also visited this area and ordered to take immediate action for preparation of DPP to save the area. For this reason, DPP has been prepared.

## 1.2 Justification/Adequacy:-

The project is technically viable since implementation of interventions will reduce vulnerability of Mongla Port Authority office, Residential Area, Roosevelt Jetty Area & Other Infrastructures from erosion of Bhairab River & the Residential area of Khulna Divisional Commissioner, District Judge, Deputy Commissioner & Superintendent of Police from the erosion of Rupsha River.

The project plays positive and active role against environmental degradation through protect the river erosion. It ensure to protect Mongla Port Authority office, Residential Area, Roosevelt Jetty Area & Other Infrastructures from erosion of Bhairab River & the Residential area of Khulna Divisional Commissioner, District Judge, Deputy Commissioner & Superintendent of Police from the erosion of Rupsha River

The project is socialy most desirable to mitigate vulnerability of Bhairab & Rupsha River.

- (i) According to recommendation of District Judge & Superintendent of Police, Khulna to facilitate construction of 2 nos RCC Speed boat Ghat & 840m walk way.
- (ii) The revised cost of this project (1st RDPP) is Tk. 2995.51 lac. As per above reason Tk. 11.47 lac has been reduced from the original DPP is Tk. 3006.98 lac.
