G. DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

General Observations/Remarks of the Project on:

1.1 Background

Barishal district is located at the mouth of three world ranking rivers, the Ganges, the Brahmputra and the Meghna, the combined flow ranking the 3rd highest in the world and having sediment load in the 1st rank. The mighty Meghna River is one of the largest rivers in Bangladesh. Huge amount of flow is discharged through the river from Meghalaya and Asam to Bay of Bengal. Ulania and Gobindapur union of Mehendigonj upazilla is situated at right bank of Meghna River. River bank erosion at Ulania and Gobindapur union was severe from 2010 to 2018. Many structures like school, madrasah, mosque, road, market, homestead, garden, paddy land etc. was engulfed into the river due to erosion. Historical Ulania jaminder houses, mosque, eadgah, school, college, madrasah, union parisad complex, health complex, post office, cyclone shelter, launch ghat, road, bridge, houses, garden, paddy land etc. was in threat due to river erosion.

0.875 km river bank protection work was implemented by Climate Change Trust Fund in 2013-14 fiscal year to protect Ulania jaminder houses and adjacent area from erosion of Meghna River. For this reason, river erosion was significantly reduced in that area. But severe river erosion was continued beyond upstream and down-stream side of the completed bank protection work. Due to severe river erosion, a part of up-stream and down-stream side of bank protection work was damaged and engulfed into the river.

Honorable member of parliament Mr. Pangkaj Nath, 122 Barishal-4, upazilla chairman, union parishadh chairman and others respected person requested to take necessary action to protect Ulania and Gabindapur area. After that a technical committee was formed by BWDB to prepare a technical report. Committee submitted a technical report on February '2016. According to the recommendation of the report, DPP was formed and approved by ECNEC on 10/04/2018.

1.2 Justification/Adequacy:

The described area was an area affected by the Meghna River. Up to 2005, the incidence of river erosion was low and from 2007, the incidence of river erosion was gradually increasing. Over the past few years, the river erosion had intensified and the river had entered about 4.00 km from its former location and most of the old Gobindpur Union had been lost to Meghna. New Char rising on the left bank of Meghna now belongs to Gobindpur Union. At that time, the set back distance was gradually decreasing due to the continued erosion of the river, the traditional Ulania jamindar houses, shops, houses, business establishments, primary schools, secondary schools, cooperative banks, health centers, agricultural lands with gardens, ice mills, and other establishments including government-owned properties was located in the mentioned area. The described property was likely to disappear in the near future. It was not possible

to determine the value of the traditional Ulania jamindar houses considering their historical importance. To protect these structures at Ulania and Gabindapur union, this project was taken and implented.

1.3. Objectives:

The main objectives of this project are-

- To protect Ulania-Gabindapur area under Mehendigonj upazila from erosion of the Meghna River in Barisal District.
- > To provide safety for human lives, properties and improve economic activities by construction of protective works at the vulnerable locations along the mighty Meghna River.
- The approximate value of the properties to be saved is Tk. 311737.40 lakh.

1.4. Project revision with reasons:

In the original DPP of the project, Tk 12984.40 lakhs against 2000 m river bank protection works, Tk 1846.06 lakhs against 2 end termination works, Tk 4762.04 lakhs against strengthening of river bank protection works (previousely executed under CCTF) and Tk 18540.00 lakhs (1,15,87,500.00 cubic meters) against river dredging work was allocated.

At that time, severe river erosion occurred along a length of 2525 m at upstream of that area in Aliganj area adjacent to the project. The erosion of the last few years had intensified and the river had entered several hundred meters towards countryside. The set back distance from houses, business establishments, primary schools, secondary schools, mosques, gardens and other structures including government-owned property and other structures located in the mentioned area was gradually decreasing as the river erosion continued. On that ground, it was required to add 2.525 km bank protection work in the 1st revised DPP. These areas were 0.925 km in upstream (from km - 0.800 to km 0.125) from existing river bank protection work (from km 0.125 to km 3.000) and 1.600 km in Aliganj area. According to the instruction of design, 100 m permanent protection work on both sides of canal and stock pile (blocks) were included in the 1st revised DPP.

On the other hand, due to morphological change, it was observed that dredging of Meghna River at the opposite of Ulania Bazar area could not be effective. But on the opposite bank of the Aliganj area, dredging work was needed. In that situation, instead of the approved 4.500 km dredging work at Ulania area, 1.60 km dredging work could be implemented on the opposite bank of Aliganj area. The savings from river dredging work item, could be used for the riverbank protection work in erosion prone area.

On 02/03/2019 Mr. Zaheed Farooque MP (Hon. Minister of State, Ministry of Water Resources) visited important places, erosion prone area in Ulania, Gobindpur and Aliganj area. During the visit,

detailed discussion and observation were made regarding the cause of erosion, the rate of erosion in the past days. He also gave directions for taking measures in vernarable areas that not included in the ongoing project.

A technical committee was formed vide Bangladesh Water Development Board's Memo No. BWDB(Sachi)/Par-1/Miscellaneous-3/2019(1st Vol.)/85; dated 21-04-2019 to form revise DPP. The Committee's report was submitted to the Board in June 2019. In view of the reality and the recommendations of the report, the DPP was revised by extending the implementation period from June 2020 to June 2021 by one year, including inclusion of new protection works in the DPP.

As per memo No. BWDB(Sachi)/Plan/Capra—2019/57 Dated 26/09/2019AD the technical report was asked to review. Accordingly, the report of the Technical Committee was reviewed and the dredging work cost of Tk 953.22 lakh was proposed. On 04-08-2019, a review meeting was held at the Ministry of Water Resources on the revised proposal of the project. The meeting discussed the details of the revision of the project and some decisions were taken. The RDPP was revised according to the decision of the review meeting.

It could be mentioned here that the maximum depth of water at Aliganj area was observed 12.00 m in May'2019 and according to this approved design was obtained from concerned design office. Following approved design estimate was prepared, tender was called and work was ongoing. At the monsoon period of 2020, velocity and discharge increased in Meghna branch river at Aliganj area. That's why depth of water also increased. Maximum depth of water at Aliganj area was observed 23.10 m in November 2019. For this reason, the design of river bank protection work at Aliganj area was revised by concern design office. In revised design dumping volume of geo-bag was increased. Besides this dredging was implemented in Meghna branch river by BIWTA to increase navigation facilities. But BIWTA did not follow the approved design of BWDB. That's why the volume of dredging was decreased. 2nd meeting of steering committee of the project was held on 25-05-2021. In the meeting, it was decided that "Additional Director General (Planning), BWDB will visit the site and submit report to the Senior Secretary, Ministry of Water Resources and Inter Item Cost Adjustment DPP will submit to the Ministry of Water Resources as early as possible". After that, Additional Director General (Planning), BWDB visited the project area and recommended to implement additional geo-bag dumping work. He also recommended that dredging should be done with the recommendation of concern design office considering updated morphological condition of that area. According to the decision of 2nd meeting of steering committee, recommendation of Additional Director General (Planning), BWDB and concern design office, Inter Item Cost Adjustment DPP was formed. This was approved by the Ministry of Water Resources on 27-03-2022.

2. Rationale of the project in respect of Concept, Design, Location and Timing:

It comes out from the study that revetment type of protection measure with provision for post construction monitoring may be taken up. An adaptive approach of bank protection could be followed in this regard. It involves the identification of priority bank protection and its implementation. The need for the subsequent work would be determined based on the river responses to the already constructed work. The study covers prediction of consequences of such partial measures that could be further fine-tuned by inclusion of updated filed data.

Detailed Cost-Estimate for physical interventions of the project for implementation of 4.525 km bank protection work, 0.875 km strengthening work and end termination work as recommended by the Technical Committee Report and included under this approved Development Project Proposal (DPP) has been prepared on the basis of approved design and later on reviewed during implementation of physical work on the basis of latest river morphology and current Schedule of Rates of Barishal O&M Circle, BWDB, Barishal.

3. Brief description on planning-and-financing-of-the-project and its applicability.

The Project was initially identified by local politicians, local elites, Public Representatives, Honorable Local Member of Parliament, Local Administrative etc. Those Stakeholders earnestly requested the Honorable Member of Parliament to address the problem of river erosion from river Meghna. Accordingly Honorable Member of Parliament sent DO letter to Honorable Minister, Ministry of Water Resources to take up the project.

♦ Project Preparation:

According to the instruction of Honorable Minister, Ministry of Water Resources & the Secretary, Ministry of Water Resources & the Director General, BWDB, the project was prepared. A Technical Committee was formed vide memo no: BWDB(Secret)/Plan-1/Mis-3/2002(9th part)/126, dated:06-10-2015 by BWDB to submit a Technical Report in respect of social, economical & environmental impact, safety of properties & infrastructure and also sustainability in the project area. Technical committee submitted a report and based on that report the project was prepared.

♦ Appraisal:

As per decision of PEC meeting the DPP was reformed & sent to the ECNEC for approval of the above project and finally the project was approved by the ECNEC on 10/04/2018. Adminstrative approval was obtained on 25/06/2018.

Close monitoring and quality control has been ensured by BWDB's concern field officer (Sub-Divisional Engineer, Executive Engineer, Superintending Engineer/ Project Director & Chief Engineer) and Taskforce member. Along with BWDB field officer, high official from BWDB headquarter, Ministry of Water Resources, Planning Comission & IMED visited the project area. Moreover, Honorable State Minister, Ministry of Water Resources and Local Honorable Member of Parliament visited the project time to time.
