The People's Republic of Bangladesh (GOB) has received a credit from International Development Association (the Bank) in an amount of US\$ 375 million and a Grant from Pilot Program for Climate Resilience (PPCR), one of the targeted programs of the Strategic Climate Fund (SCF) under the Climate Investment Funds (CIF) of US\$ 25 million to meet the implementation cost of the CEIP-1. The overall project development objective is to increase the resilience of coastal population to natural disasters and climate change by rehabilitating and improving the polder system in the contiguous six coastal districts comprising Satkhira, Khulna, Bagerhat, Pirojpur, Barguna and Patuakhali Districts. The proceeds from this credit would be used to eligible payments under this contract for **Procurement of Motor Vehicles**.

2. The Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) represented by the Project Director (PD), CEIP-1, BWDB now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **procurement of 10 Nos. 4-WD motor vehicle(Lot 1) and 2 nos. microbus(Lot 2)** to be supplied at 72, Green road, BWDB premises, Dhaka. Delivery period between 10 and 16 weeks after opening of Letter of Credit; and no margin of preference will be applicable for domestic bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*, January 2011 (Procurement Guidelines), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the office of the PD, CEIP-1 and inspect the bidding documents during 0900 to 1700 hours on all working days at the address given below.

5. A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of BDT **5000.00 or USD 65.00**. The method of payment will be *either* Demand Draft (DD)/Payment Order (PO) issued by a scheduled bank in Bangladesh *or* a cashier's or

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certified check issued by a reputed bank in an eligible foreign country favouring Deputy Director, Central RAC, BWDB, Motijheel, Dhaka. The bidding documents can be *either* purchased personally *or* sent by airmail upon request.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **3:30 p.m. (Bangladesh Standard Time, GMT + 6 hours) of 19 February 2015**. Electronic bidding *will not* be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **19 February 2015 at 4:00 p.m (Bangladesh Standard Time, GMT + 6 hours)**.

7. All bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security of either BDT 800,000.00 or USD 10,500.00 for Lot 1 and either BDT 150,000.00 or USD 2,000.00 in the form required in the bidding documents.**

8. The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the BIDs, or annul the process at any stage without assigning any reason(s) whatsoever and without incurring any liability to the affected applicant(s).

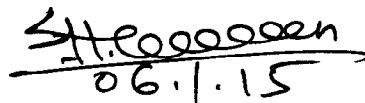
