The Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Coastal Embankment Improvement Project, Phase-1(CEIP-1), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Rehabilitation/Reconstruction & Upgrading of Polder 32, 33, 35/1 and 35/3 under Coastal Embankment Improvement Project, Phase-1, (CEIP-1).

The Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Rehabilitation/Reconstruction & Upgrading of Polders under Coastal Embankment Improvement Project, Phase-1(CEIP-1) in Upazilas Dacope, Sharankhola and Bagerhat, in the district of Khulna & Bagerhat.

The contract involves the following major items of works to be executed over a period of three (3) years;

A margin of preference of 7.5% (seven and one-half percent) shall be granted to domestic contractors, in accordance with, and subject to provisions stipulated in the Bidding Document.

Minimum Qualification Requirements of the bidder are not limited to the followings;

- i). It has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means (independent of any contractual advance payment) sufficient to meet the construction cash flow requirements estimated as US\$ **11.00 million** for the subject contract(s) net of the Bidders other commitments;
- ii) It shall have adequate sources of finance to meet the cash flow requirements on works currently in progress and for future contract commitments;
- iii) The minimum average annual construction turnover of US\$ **50.00 (fifty) million**, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress and/or completed within the last **5 (five)** years, divided by **5 (five)** years;
- iv) It has construction experience under construction contracts in the role of prime contractor, JV member, sub-contractor, or management contractor for at least the last **10 (ten)** years, starting 1st January **2005**;
- v) A minimum number of similar contracts specified below that have been satisfactorily and substantially completed as a prime contractor, joint venture member, management contractor or sub-contractor between 1st January 2005 and bid submission deadline:
 - (a) **Two (2) contracts**, each of minimum value US\$ **80 million**;
 - Or
 - (b) **One (1) contract** of minimum value of US\$ **160 million**;

Details of Qualification Requirements have been provided under Section 3: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, of the Bidding Document

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: *Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011*, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. A Bidder shall be ineligible for the bid, if it has been debarred by any government entity of Bangladesh and the debarment notice has been published on the CPTU website

A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of **BDT 24,000.00 (Bangladeshi Taka Twenty Four Thousands) or USD 300.00 (United State Dollar Three Hundred)**. The method of payment will be in the form of Demand Draft/ Pay Order issued by a scheduled bank in Bangladesh *or* a cashier's or certified check issued by a reputed bank in an eligible foreign country favouring Deputy Director, Central RAC, BWDB, Motijheel, Dhaka. The bidding document being voluminous one (more than 1200 sheets of drawing with each set of bidding document), delivery of bidding document by surface mail or



courier or air mail shall not be made to avoid any misplacement or delay. All the interested eligible bidders (both local overseas) are advised to take hand to hand delivery of the bidding documents from the office at the address below by themselves or through their authorized representatives.

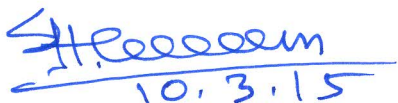
The bidding document along with a few characteristic Drawings as sample (Embankment, Structure, Bank Protection Work, Slope Protection Work, Drainage Channel and Closure Dam) of Polder No.32 (out of four Polders) will be posted in Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB)'s website: www.bwdb.gov.bd for the interested eligible bidders to look into.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m. on 01-04-2015 and on 02-04-2015 in the Conference Room of Bangladesh Water Development Board, WAPDA Building (3rd Floor), Motijheel C/A, Dhaka-1000, Bangladesh.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **23-04-2015 up to 3:00 PM (BST)**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on **23-04-2015 at 3:30 PM (BST)**

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of **BDT 100.00 million or USD 1.30 million**.
