1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) with an ADB administered co-financing grant from the Government of Netherlands toward the cost of Flood and Riverbank Risk Management Investment Program (FRERMIP) Project-1 and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the project fund to payment under the Contract for procurement of Geo-textile Bags for Package No. G-04/2016-2017.
2. The Bangladesh Water Development Board now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Procurement of Geo-Textile Bags for One (1) package. The International Competitive Bidding Method will be followed for Procurement of Geo-Textile Bags strictly in conformity with the "Technical Specifications" and Delivery Schedule provided in the Bidding Documents. The Geo-textile bags to be delivered at the FRERMIP Project site, Bangladesh; is given below,

Completion of Delivery applicable to Package G-04/2016-2017:

- a. In the case of geo-textile bags being fabricated and supplied from within Purchaser's country with geo-textiles imported from outside the Purchaser's country, or completed geo-textile bags are supplied from outside the Purchase's country:

Shipment of geo-textile fabric or bags should commence within Four (4) weeks from the date of confirmation of the Letter of Credit (L/C) by the Beneficiary's Bank in case of bid price quoted in foreign currency and from the date of signing of contract in case of bid price quoted in local currency. Delivery of 30% of finished goods (geo-textile bags) of the Package to the designated site shall be completed within Eight (8) weeks from the date of confirmation of the L/C, up to 70% within Thirteen (13) weeks from the date of confirmation of the L/C by the Beneficiary's Bank and the balance of 30% by next Three (3) weeks.

- b. In the case of geo-textile bags being fabricated and supplied from within Purchaser's country:

Delivery to be commenced within Three (3) weeks from the date of confirmation of the L/C by the Beneficiary's Bank in case of bid price quoted in foreign currency and from the date of signing of contract in case of bid price quoted in local currency. Delivery of 30% of finished goods (geo-textile bags) of the Package to the designated site shall be completed within Seven (7) weeks from the date of confirmation of the L/C, up to 70% within Twelve (12) weeks from the date of confirmation of the L/C by the Beneficiary's Bank and the balance of 30% by the next Three (3) weeks.

3. International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single Stage, One-Envelop procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries.
4. Evaluation and comparison will be done in accordance with the evaluation criteria as provided in Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, of the bidding document. The Bidders may obtain further information from the Project Director, FRERMIP and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 1000 hours (BST) to 1300 hours (BST) in all working days.



5. The Bidding Document in English language, may be purchased by interested Bidders on submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Tk. 7500/= (Taka seven thousand five hundred) only or United States Dollar 100. The method of payment will be through a Pay Order issued by a scheduled Bangladeshi Bank located in Dhaka or a Demand Draft or Cashier's Check drawn in favor of the Deputy Director, Dhaka Regional Accounting Center (RAC), BWDB, Dhaka, Bangladesh from a Bank located in Bangladesh or in Bidder's country acceptable to the Purchaser. The document may be collected by the authorized representative of the Bidder. In case of overseas delivery, the bidding documents will be sent by courier services upon payment of the fee in the manner stated above. No liability will be accepted for loss and late delivery.
6. A pre-bid meeting will be held at the office of the Project Director, FRERMIP, at the address given below, on **23-10-2016 11:00 A.M. (BST)**. Bidders' representatives are invited and encouraged to attend the meeting.
7. Bid must be submitted to the address given below. The name and title of the procurement package shall be clearly marked on the outer surface of the envelop containing the full bid proposal i.e "Bid offer for the supply of Geo-Textile Bags" Package No. G-04/2016-2017. Bid must be accompanied by bid security. The particulars and amount of bid security is mentioned in Bid Data Sheet (corresponding ITB is 21). Bid will be received at the address below up to **14.00 hours (BST) on 14-11-2016**. Bid will be opened at the same place at **14.30 hours (BST) on 14-11-2016** in presence of the Bidders or Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at undersigned office. Late bids shall be rejected and returned unopened. The last selling date of Bidding Document is on **13-11-2016** up to Office Hours (1700 BST).
8. This IFB can also be found in the official web address of Bangladesh Water Development Board (<https://www.bwdb.gov.bd/>), Central Procurement Technical Unit (<https://www.cptu.gov.bd/>) and the Business Opportunities of adb.org (<https://www.adb.org/>) respectively.
9. The Bangladesh water Development Board will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or submission of Bids.
10. In the comparison of bids, ADB's domestic preference scheme will be applied in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Instructions to Bidder of the Bidding Document.
11. Notification of award will be issued subject to availability of budget.
12. Quantity of geo-bag supply may be increased or decreased and will be finalised during issuance of NOA and contract signing on the basis of field conditions.
13. The Bangladesh Water Development Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
