1. The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) has received financing from International Development Association (IDA) to meet part of the cost of the Coastal Embankment Improvement Project, Phase-1 (CEIP-1). The overall **objective** of the CEIP-1 is to increase the resilience of coastal population to natural disasters and climate change. More specifically, the project aims at (a) reducing the loss of assets, crops and livestock during natural disasters; (b) reducing the time of recovery after natural disaster such as cyclone; (c) improving agricultural production by reducing saline water intrusion which is expected to worsen due climate change; and (d) improving the Government of Bangladesh's capacity to respond promptly and effectively to an eligible crisis or emergency. This objective will be achieved by **rehabilitating and improving the polder system in the coastal area**. The project is expected to be implemented over 7-8 years. The project is spread over 6 districts in coastal area of Bangladesh, viz., Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira, Pirojpur, Borguna and Patuakhali.

The Project would be implemented by the Ministry of Water Resources (MOWR), through the Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB). BWDB has set up a Project Management Unit (PMU) to oversee the development and execution of the project. The PMU is led by a Project Director and located in BWDB's headquarters in Dhaka. Also, one Field Level Offices (FO), at Khulna has been set up headed by an Executive Engineer. PMU is being assisted by a Detailed Design & Construction and Supervision (DDCS) & Project Management Support (PMS) Consultants and a Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Consultants. The PMU will /has appoint/appointed an Independent Panel of Experts (IPOE) to oversee the technical implementation of the project.

As part of the CEIP Field Offices at Khulna, Bagerhat, Patuakhali and Borguna, the BWDB plans to hire a highly qualified Social Specialist/ Economist with sound knowledge and expertise of (i) land acquisition in Bangladesh; (ii) management of social safeguards compliance issues in infrastructure projects under the World Bank Social Safeguards Operational Policy on

Involuntary Resettlement (OP 4.12); and (iii) social mobilization and participation in water management.

2. Key Functions of the Social Specialist/ Economist:

The overall responsibility of the Social Specialist/ Economist will be to perform the tasks of land acquisition process for selected polders, compensate affected persons, resettle rehabilitate them through preparation and implementation of Resettlement Action Plans, and supervise and monitor the social mobilization and participatory water management activities.

The scope of work for the position are as follows:

- A. Land Acquisition
- B. Social Impact Assessment and Resettlement Planning
- C. Implementation of RAPs
- D. Supervision of Social Mobilization and Participatory Water Management Activities

Details of assignments are furnished in the Terms of Reference (TOR). Interested Applicant(s) may obtain the TOR in the BWDB's official website: www.bwdb.gov.bd.

3. Qualifications and Experiences:

The Social Specialist/Economist should have minimum Masters' degree in sociology/ economics/social welfare and any other social sciences with about 10 years of work experience of which at least 5 years should be directly related to the relevant tasks of land acquisition and resettlement. The specialist must have demonstrated sound technical expertise in international good practices on social safeguards and have proven track record of providing social safeguard oversight functions. Knowledge of World Bank/ Asian Development Bank or similar development partners' processes and guidelines on social safeguards will be necessary. S/he must have excellent communication and writing skills with higher-level computer skills in Windows operating system (Word, Excel, Access, Power Point, etc.) and other applications

4. Duration of the Assignment:

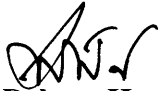
Duration of the consultancy services would be for **24 (twenty four) months**. However the performance for first year will determine the continuity of the contract for the remaining year. The contract may be extended based on project needs and subject to satisfactory performance of the consultant.

5. Selection Procedures:

BWDB now seeks the application from eligible applicants to express their interest in providing services (complete CV with detail information about employment history with duties and responsibilities, current remuneration, academic details, major publication(if any), contract address including telephone number and e-mail) . The consultants will be selected in accordance with World Bank Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by the World Bank Borrowers, [January 2011 (Revised July 2014)]. Applicants currently in government service in the client's country may apply only if they satisfy Paragraph 1.13 (d) of the Consultant Guidelines.
